If you are a High, or a descendant of the High family of Thomas High of Virginia, or if you think you might be and want to find out for sure, you need to join the High Family Association! Dues are only \$25 per year. As a member you will receive the High Family Journal that is published twice each year in January and July. Thomas High came to Virginia from England in 1660. Through more than two decades of research we now generally know all of the branches of the family tree regardless of where you might now live. We maintain a computerized database of all Highs who send us their line, and it is generally possible to connect you to the main family tree.

If you are researching your branch of the family, but do not yet have enough information to connect to the family tree, we keep your material and notify you when we learn enough to make the connection.
